









Activity: The Bug Scavenger Hunt

Count the legs on a millipede.	Find a spider web outside in the grass.	 <p>Moth</p>	Count how many bugs visit one flower in one minute.	Look under a rock.
 <p>Larva</p>	Watch a caterpillar move.	Count the eyestalks and tentacles on a slug.	Rescue worms on a rainy day.	Find a bug hiding in the bark of a tree.
Find a spider egg sack wrapped in white silk.	Look for bugs around a light at night.	Worm poop – it looks like (and is) small piles of round dirt balls.	 <p>Grasshopper</p>	Find a wiggly mosquito larva in a water filled container.
