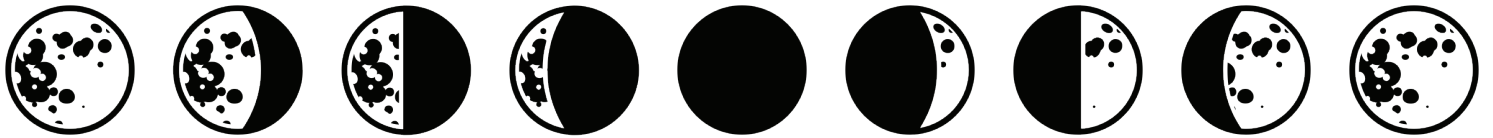












Moon Scavenger Hunt
