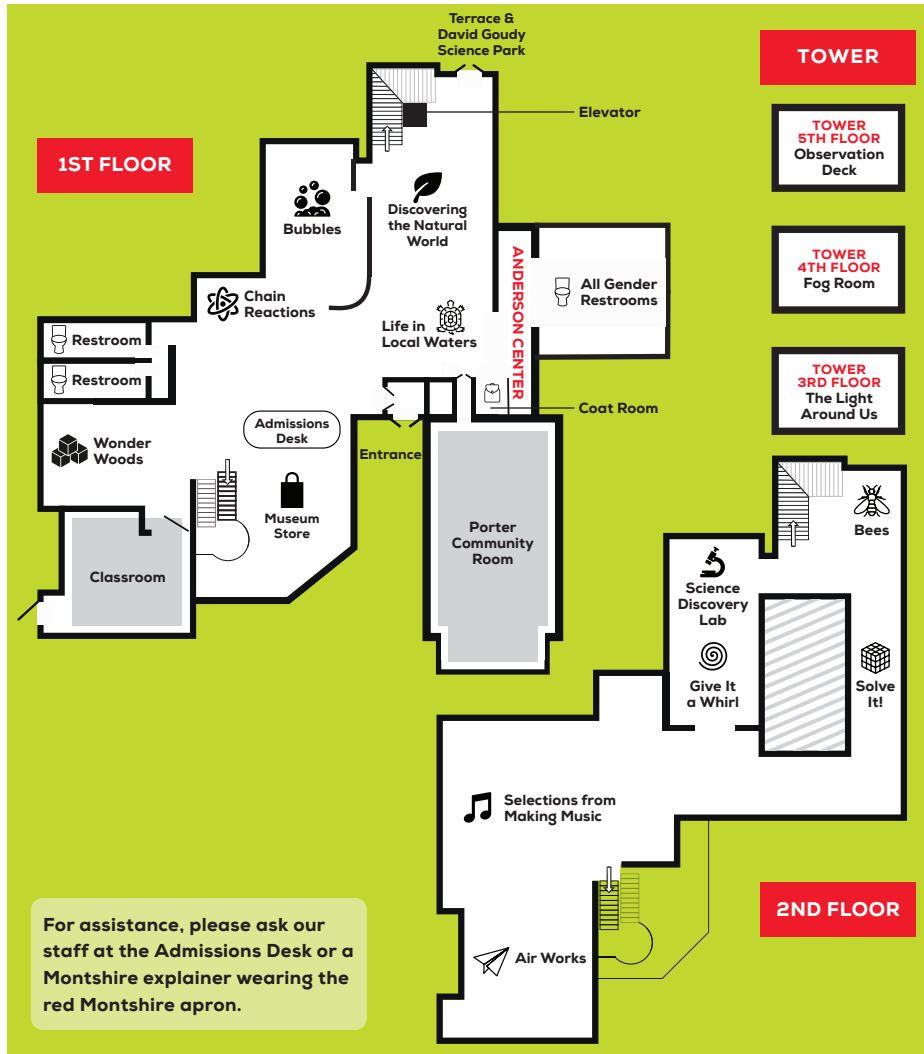

VISITOR GUIDELINES

HEALTHY VISITORS

Visitors must show no symptoms of illness.

FACE MASKS

Visitors ages three and up are required to wear a face mask when inside the building. Face masks must be worn outside when interacting with Museum staff or other visitors.

SOCIAL DISTANCE

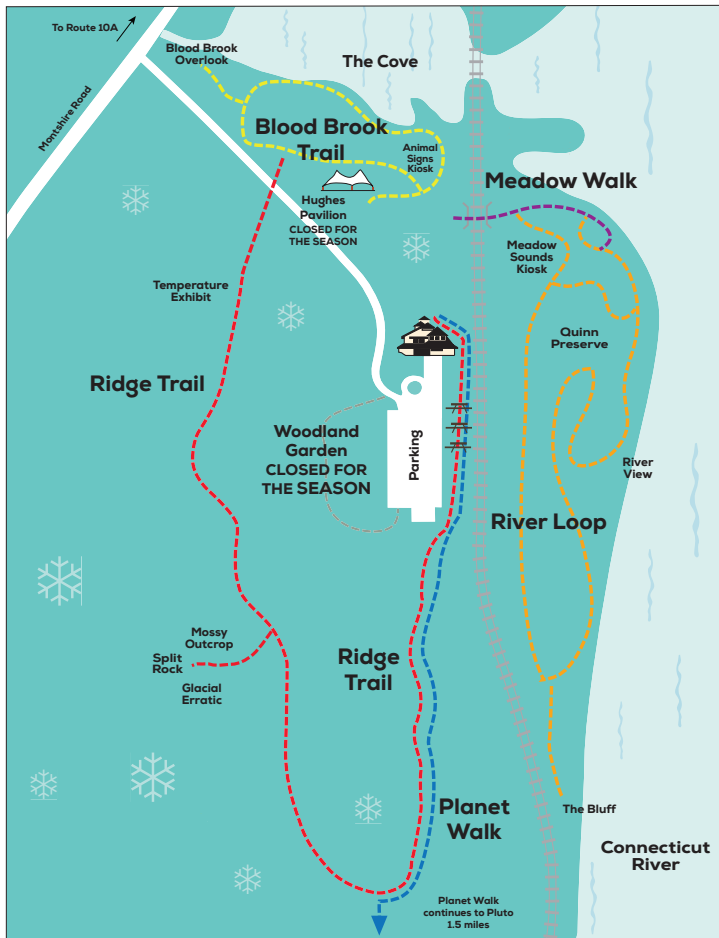
We encourage everyone in your group to maintain at least a six feet distance from other visitors or Museum staff. Children must stay with their adults at all times.

FOOD AND DRINK AT DESIGNATED OUTDOOR DINING AREAS ONLY

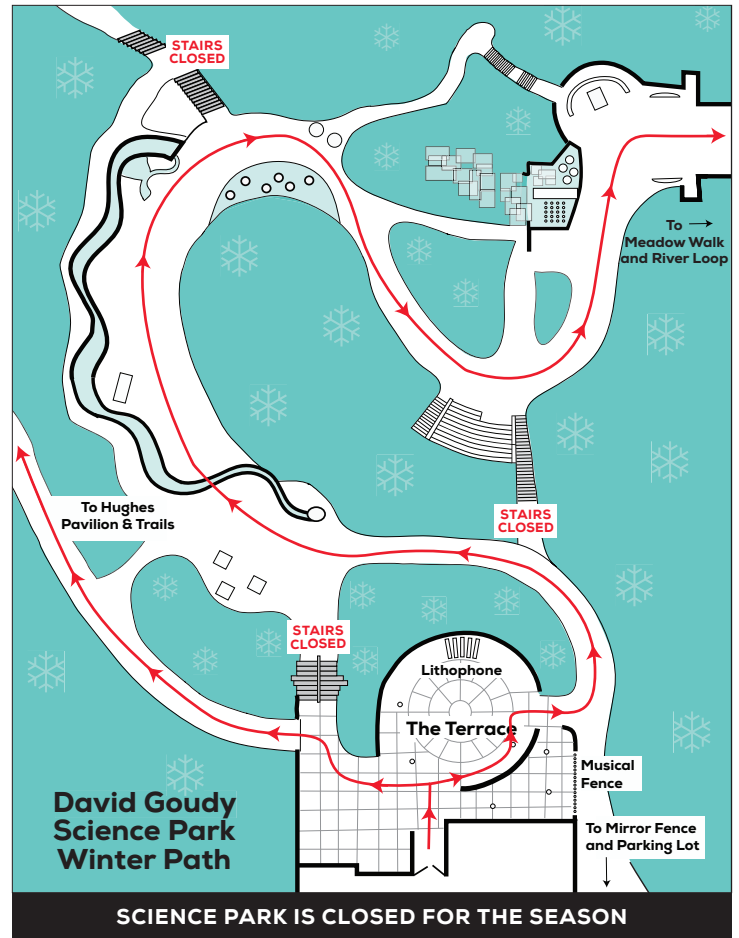
Eating or drinking are only permitted outside, in the designated areas. No eating and drinking in the building.

GENERAL INFORMATION

DINING AREAS

There are picnic tables and areas for dining outside. No eating and drinking is permitted in the Montshire building.

TRAIL INFO

Please stay on the trails. Leave plants and animals undisturbed.

NO SMOKING

Smoking is permitted in the parking lot only.

FIRST AID

Please ask any Montshire employee if you need assistance.

NO PETS

Pets are only permitted in the parking lot, with the exception of service animals.

AMENITIES AT MUSEUM STORE

Amenities (e.g., water bottles, sunscreen) are available for sale in the Museum Store.

ACCESSIBILITY

Some trails are accessible by wheelchair or stroller.

Sensory resources are available to borrow at the Admissions Desk.

OUTDOOR EXPERIENCES AND TRAILS

We encourage you to explore the varied landscape and trailside exhibits along our walking trails. During the winter, trails are not maintained.

Snowshoes (available at the front desk) or strap-on ice spikes are recommended. River Loop is the recommended trail for snowshoeing.

Meadow Walk (0.3 mile)

A walk in the Quinn Nature Preserve, along a meadow.



River Loop (0.8 mile)

Blood Brook Trail (0.4 mile)

A trail with variety, from an open field to a grove of trees.



Ridge Trail (1 mile)

A rugged trail with exhibits that explore ecology.



Planet Walk (3 miles to Pluto and back)

A scale-model journey that travels the solar system.
